## **Participants will:**

- Make connections with parents in similar situations.
- Increase confidence and self-esteem.
- Learn how to balance work, education and family life.
- Be challenged and inspired to create a new future.
- Improve CV and interview skills.
- Explore careers and education courses and how to access them.

Participants engage two mornings per week in online facilitated classes via Zoom and also engage in two hours per week of self-directed online learning. No classes take place during school holidays.

## Wrap-around supports include:

One to one support with a designated key worker.

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- Counselling support.
- Parent Mentoring support.
- Access to online parenting programmes.
- Small subsidy for technical items.
